



Fall 2017 Class Supply List: Advanced Figure Painting/ 7FAC29FB
(Please see new policy re: class supplies below this list.)

Drawing Materials:

- 16 X 20 Inch drawing pad
- Extra soft thin and thick vine charcoal and a kneaded eraser

Oil/Acrylic Paint Colors:

- Cadmium Yellow Light or Medium
- Yellow Ochre or Raw Sienna
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cadmium Red Light or Medium
- Alizarin Crimson
- Viridian Green
- Burnt Sienna
- Mars Black
- Titanium White (large tube)
- Cerulean Blue
- Cadmium Yellow Light (or Hansa or Lemon Yellow)
- Cadmium Orange

Media:

- For oil paints only: Linseed or Walnut, Artist grade Odorless Mineral Spirits (Gamsol or Turpernoid, but not turpenoid natural)
- Gloss or Matte medium (for acrylic paints only)

Paint Brushes:

- A range of sizes and shapes, such as:
 - o Rounds Numbers 2 or 3
 - o Flat or Filbert brush #10 and #8
 - o Bright Brush #7 and #5

Supports:

- Canvas Boards, Canvas Paper or Stretched Canvases (not smaller than 11"X14")
- Or: Masonite Boards and Acrylic Gesso

Other:

- Large Paper or Plexi Palette
- 2 jars with lids
- Paper Towels
- Palette Knife trowel shaped blade 1 ½ to 2 ½ inches long

NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, **Beginner-level classes**. These classes will be noted in the class description with "Some supplies included." Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in **Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes**, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require **unconventional materials** (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
