



Fall 2017 Class Supply List: Beginning Acrylic Painting / 7FAC20TA
(Please see new policy re: class supplies below this list.)

- Drawing Materials:
 - 6 X 20 Inch drawing pad
 - Extra soft thin and thick vine charcoal and a kneaded eraser
- Acrylic Paint Colors:
 - Cadmium Yellow Light or Medium
 - Yellow Ochre or Raw Sienna
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Cadmium Red Light or Medium
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Viridian Green
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Mars Black
 - Titanium White (large tube)
- Media:
 - Gloss or Matte medium
- Paint Brushes:
 - A range of sizes and shapes, such as:
 - Rounds Numbers 2 or 3
 - Flat brush #10 and #8
 - Bright Brush #7 and #5
- Supports:
 - Canvas Boards, Canvas Paper or Stretched Canvases (not smaller than 11"X14")
 - Gessoed Masonite boards
- Other:
 - Large Paper or Plexiglass Palette
 - 2 jars with lids
 - Paper Towels
 - Palette Knife trowel shaped blade 1 ½ to 2 ½ inches long

NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, Beginner-level classes. These classes will be noted in the class description with "Some supplies included." Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes, or any class without the

notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require unconventional materials (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
