



Fall 2017 Class Supply List: Beginning Watercolor / 7FAC40WB  
(Please see new policy re: class supplies below this list.)

- Watercolor paint in tubes: *Winsor-Newton Cotman (student grade) watercolors will be fine. Winsor-Newton artists' grade watercolors are excellent, but more expensive.*
  - Alizarin Crimson
  - Cadmium Red or Bright Red
  - Cadmium Yellow Light or Cadmium Lemon
  - Cadmium Orange
  - Cobalt Blue or Ultramarine Blue
  - Hooker's Green
  - Raw Umber

*If you already have watercolors, and would like to add to your palette, the following are nice to have:*

- Prussian Blue, Viridian Green, Quinacridone Violet or Dioxine Violet
- Round watercolor brush that comes to a fine point, #10 or larger. *A good inexpensive brush is Loew-Cornell brand 7020 ultra round, size 12 (black and red handle)*
- White mixing tray, any size
- 4 full sheets (22x30 inches) 140lb. good quality **cold-press** watercolor paper, (ex: Fabriano, Strathmore, Canson, or Arches) *Bring only one sheet at a time to class.*
- Lightweight board or surface to support paper (such as masonite or foamcore), at least 18x24 inches
- Drafting tape
- HB drawing pencil and Design brand kneaded eraser
- Clean absorbent cotton or linen rag or paper towels
- Empty container for water
