



## Spring 2018 Class Supply List: Painting for Beginners (Please see new policy re: class supplies below this list.)

- Drawing Materials
  - 16 x 20 drawing pad
  - Extra Soft thin and thick vine charcoal and a kneaded eraser
  
- Acrylic paint:
  - Titanium white (large tube)
  - Mars Black
  - Cadmium yellow light or medium
  - Cadmium red light or medium
  - Alizarin Crimson
  - Viridian Green
  - Ultramarine blue
  - Yellow ochre or Raw Sienna
  - Burnt sienna
  
- Various size brushes with stiff bristles, such as
  - #5,#7 bright
  - #8, #10 flats
  - #2,#3 rounds
  - filberts
- Gloss or Matte Acrylic Medium
- Large paper or plexiglass palette
- Palette knife
- Painting surfaces in a variety of sizes (not smaller than 11x14")
  - Canvas Boards
  - Canvas Paper
  - Stretched Canvases
  - Gessoed Masonite or wood
- Paper towels and/or rags
- 2 jars with lids
- Palette knife trowel shaped blade 1 ½ to 2 1/1 inches long

### NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, **Beginner-level classes**. These classes will be noted in the class description with "Some supplies included." Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in **Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes**, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require **unconventional materials** (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
