- acrylic matte medium
- Collage supplies: wrapping paper, fancy papers, magazines, scraps, old patterns, etc.
- Scissors
- masking tape
- brushes
- acrylics (if you would like)
- oil pastels
- 5 surfaces to create on, suggestions: 9X12 or smaller, canvas boards, heavy cardboard, wood scraps, wood box tops, heavy paper that won't buckle
- contact paper from hardware store
- pencils and paper
- something to cut on,,, heavy cardboard or a plastic cutting surfaces
- newspaper
- matte knife and blades
- palette knife

### NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, **Beginner-level classes**. These classes will be noted in the class description with "Some supplies included." Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in **Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes**, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require **unconventional materials** (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
