(Please see new policy re: class supplies below this list.)

- PAINTS:
 - Cadmium Yellow
 - Medium Cadmium Red
 - Medium Alizarin Crimson
 - Cerulean Blue
 - Phthalo Blue
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Titanium White
 - Bring any additional colors you already have.
 - (Recommend for acrylic: Liquitex or Utrecht (student))
 - (Recommend for oils: Winsor & Newton or Utrecht (student))
- MEDIUM:
 - Recommend for acrylic: Golden Acrylic Glazing Liquid (Satin or Gloss)
 - (Recommend for oil: Winsor & Newton Liquin or Odorless Mineral Spirits)
- PALETTE:
 - paper or tray
- BRUSHES:
 - bring assortment
- SURFACE:
 - Primed surface of your choice (at least 12x16") or Arches Oil Painting 12x16 Paper Pads (for both acrylic & oil use)
- DRAWING:
 - pencil/charcoal and paper (newsprint is fine)
- MISC:
 - rags/paper towels
 - jars/containers (plastic for acrylic, glass for oil)
- OPTIONAL:
 - Gloves or Barrier Cream (i.e. Winsor & Newton Artguard)
 - Airtight Stainless Steel Brush Washer (i.e. Newton Air-Tight Deluxe Brush Washer or Artria Steel Brush Bath) or "Masters" Brush Cleaner
 - Apron

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, **Beginner-level classes**. These classes will be noted in the class description with "Some supplies included." Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in **Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes**, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require **unconventional materials** (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
