



Winter 2018 Class Supply List: Gelatin Print Design / 8WAC71TB

- Gelli Plate (6x6 or 8x10)
- Brayer
- Paper pad (Bristol board smooth or mixed media pad) slightly larger than plate, 8x10, 9x12, 11x14, as long as there is a 1-2" border around plate
- Acrylic paint- any color, any brand
- matte or gloss medium
- brushes of various sizes
- hand sanitizer or wet wipes
- drafting tape, 1" or 1 ½ "
- textured materials- stencils, stamps, mesh, anything plastic or rubber you can roll paint onto

NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, **Beginner-level classes**. These classes will be noted in the class description with "Some supplies included." Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in **Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes**, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require **unconventional materials** (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
