



Spring 2017 Class Supply List: Palette Knife Painting / 7SAC32WA (Please see new policy re: class supplies below this list.)

- A couple of small-ish canvases or canvas boards (8x10, 9x12, 11x14, or 16x20)
- At least three palette knives: either teardrop, diamond, or oblong shaped, approximately 1.5-2 inches long
- Paints of your choice, along with appropriate media such as turpenoid for oils and gel medium for acrylic
- Brushes of your choice
- Jars for rinsing
- Palette: plexiglass or plastic tray
- Drawing pencil and sketchbook
- Masking tape
- Paper towels

NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, **Beginner-level classes**. These classes will be noted in the class description with "Some supplies included." Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in **Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes**, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require **unconventional materials** (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
