(Please see new policy re: class supplies below this list.)

- Oil or acrylic paint:
- Titanium white
- Cadmium yellow light or lemon yellow
- Cadmium yellow medium
- Cadmium red light
- Alizarin red
- Cerulean blue
- Ultramarine blue
- Yellow ochre
- Burnt sienna
- Viridian (add on but not necessary)
- paper palette
- palette knife
- paper towels
- various sized brushes/ filberts, rounds, flats
- spray bottle for acrylic paint
- watercolor paper pad, 18x24, 140 lb. works best
- Oil paint medium, if needed use odorless mineral spirits and linseed oil or other natural oil for thinning paint.
- canvas/support, aprox. 18"x24" or 16"x20"

NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, **Beginner-level classes**. These classes will be noted in the class description with "Some supplies included." Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in **Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes**, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require **unconventional materials** (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
