- Acrylic paints in colors of your choice
- White drawing paper
- 3 or more canvas boards, 9 x 12
- Selection of brushes
- Palette knife
- Roll of paper towels
- Roll of masking tape
- Palette paper
- 2 large plastic cups for water
- Scissors

The following are the various items we will use to create textures. Many of these are everyday household items. It is not necessary to bring every single one, but the demos will be shown using each of them. The more you bring, the more you can try!

- Acrylic gel medium
- Roll of plastic wrap
- White glue
- Squirt bottle
- Cellulose sponge
- Rubbing alcohol
- Petroleum jelly
- Tissue paper
- Crayons or oil pastels
- Hair comb
- Toothbrush
- Roll of clear packing tape
- Magazines
- Fabric and/or paper for collage

- Small items for collage (e.g. buttons, dice, beads, keys, etc.)

NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, **Beginner-level classes**. These classes will be noted in the class description with “Some supplies included.” Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in **Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes**, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require **unconventional materials** (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
