- Charcoal pencils, soft
- Soft vine charcoal
- Compressed charcoal, soft
- 2B conte crayon
- White rubber eraser
- Ebony pencils

- Masking tape
- Paint and Brushes of your choice
- Painting medium for the paint you will be using
- Painting surface of your choice 18 x 24 or smaller
- Palette
- Jars for use with medium

NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, Beginner-level classes. These classes will be noted in the class description with "Some supplies included." Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require unconventional materials (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
