### **ABOUT OFF THE WALL**

Danforth Art Museum\School presents two annual juried exhibitions—Off the Wall and Community of Artists—highly anticipated shows featuring some of the top artistic talent in New England. Because these incredible exhibitions include work by both emerging talent and renowned established artists, they draw wide-spread attention from art critics, gallerists, and art collectors, and provide exposure for artists in all media for curatorial consideration for future exhibitions at Danforth Art and beyond. Each year Danforth Art chooses an outstanding curator who makes selections for Off the Wall that align with his or her curatorial vision.



### **ABOUT OUR JUROR**

Katherine French is Director Emerita at Danforth Art and Gallery Director at Catamount Arts in St. Johnsbury, VT. Acclaimed for exhibitions exploring historical and contemporary expressionism, French was recipient of an award for curatorial excellence from the New England chapter of the International Association of Art Critics. She was also named Best Curator of Locally Made Art at the Boston Art Awards and subject of profiles in Art New England and the Boston Globe. Twice recognized as one of Ten to Watch, she has been designated a Distinguished Alumna by Boston University. Under her direction, Danforth Art, Museum\School was named an Outstanding Cultural Organization by the Massachusetts Arts Education Collaborative.

### JUROR'S STATEMENT

As former director, I was honored to jury work for the 2015 Off the Wall as a lovely way to say goodbye to a special audience of artists and art-lovers I've come to know over my ten years at Danforth Art. Although the uniformly high quality of the more than 1200 of submissions by nearly 500 artists made selection difficult of only 100 works, I am extraordinarily proud of the results. The talent that exists throughout the region, and within Danforth Art's membership, is truly remarkable.

This year's Off the Wall demonstrates incredible range. From the delicately blown glass of Stephanie Chubbuck; to Mark Del Guidice's fine arts furniture; to Sara Fine Wilson's or Ronnie Gould's energetically-charged ceramic work; to Ellen Solari's basketry; to the mixed media assemblage of Lisa Barthelson, Conny Goelz-Schmitt, Leslie Sills, Jessica Straus and Antoinette Winters: we see clear proof that the line between craft and fine art is a very thin one indeed.

Love of process and material was evident in both abstract and representational work, and played a part in the final selection. The loose, expressive style of Aileen Callahan, Barbara Ishikura, Iris Osterman, and Robin Reynolds, is balanced by the no less painterly, yet restrained works by Stephen Imrich, Linda Pearlman Karlsberg, Laurie Simko, Carole Rabe, and Carol Schweigert. Lissa Banks' Sunbathing Clementine and Myrna Beecher's Peaches are small, but perfectly formed—like their more lushly painted counterparts by Beverly Rippel or Lisa Gabrielle Russell. Love of material also leads to experimentation, which grows proud of surface in the hydro stone rise of Ilana Manolson's Sample of One or in Vivian Pratt's twisting branch coming off Untitled 1504.

A serious approach to art, combined with a sense of humor, was also appreciated. Scott Barry's Huh?, Susan Gilbert's The Pope's Birthday, Judith Robinson-Cox's Monkey Business, Wendy Seller's Long Shot, Stephen Sheffield's Businessman in Miniature range from wryly comical to outright funny, but are each visually smart in a uniquely quirky way. A sense of the surreal also appealed—as evidenced in Susan Lewinnek's Market, Havana, Cuba, Susan Lirakis's Witness, Louise Weinberg's One Fish, Two Fish, or Jenny Wiener's Wolf—proof that art can reveal haunting, dream-like images that inform our sense of reality.

Memory and imagination in representational art is an interest of this curator, and poetic reinterpretation of memory certainly plays a key role in Linda Anderson's Homegrown, Adrienne DerMarderosian's Migration, Bonnie Lerner's Flo in Her Snowsuit, Cheryl Polcaro's Girl with Marionette, and Astrid Reischwitz's Spinneklump (Spin Club). This was especially true in Patricia Schappler's Coming and Going, Mary Spencer's Seth with Honey Bees, Ken Tighe's Untitled, and Kate True's Flora in Spring: each display the artist's virtuosic ability to go beyond facility in order to extract a deeper, more resonant meaning by filtering it through emotion.

Finally, in a museum where the exhibitions I have curated have focused on art inspired by experience, it should have come as no surprise that many submissions reflected the hard winter of 2015. David Mangels' Frozen Mosaic No.1 and C.E. Morse's Noberron #81 were only two of many ice crystal studies, while others like Fernando Martins' Release or Cameron Roberts' Buds Emerging were invested in presenting the promise of a new season of growth. More than one visitor this summer will take pleasure in the title of John Rich's photograph Where Snow Goes to Die 1.

In the end, this year's *Off the Wall* supports a visual conversation that is constantly taking place within this curator's head—one that I am pleased to share. Thanks go to Danforth Art's Associate Curator Jessica Roscio and Museum Registrar Kristina Wilson, whose dedication and hard work make *Off the Wall* and *Community of Artists* possible. Appreciation also goes to Danforth Art's member artists, and to those artists who are new to Danforth Art, for their willingness to engage with an institution where it's possible to both make and exhibit art. I congratulate all those who were selected and all those who applied. It is art that inspires and remains at the core of everything, and I continue to be grateful to artists for their commitment to make it.




