Paint: Buy the best quality you can afford

- **Suggested colors:**
- Cadmium yellow
- Lemon yellow
- Venetian red or red oxide
- Quinacridone red
- Ultramarine blue
- Cerulean blue
- Titanium white
- Ivory black
- **Nice to have:**
- Whites: flake, cremnitz, zinc
- Nickel titanate
- Cadmium yellow deep
- Indian yellow,
- Raw sienna or Yellow ochre
- Burnt sienna
- Cadmium red
- Quinacridone magenta
- Phthalo or Prussian blue
- Cobalt
- Sap green permanent
- Viridian
- Prussian green
- Dioxazine purple or other purple or violet
- Raw umber
- Mars black

Other:

- Notebook and pen to write notes, sketchbook
- Drawing pencil or pen
- Tracing paper
- Painters or masking tape
- Pencil sharpener or knife
- Eraser

- Binder clips
- **Nitrile disposable gloves (latex not recommended)**
- Stretched canvas, linen, paper or Masonite panels, small to medium size 9x12 — 18x24
- Palette: preferably wood, glass, or plexi glass; paper palettes okay but not preferred
- At least two palette knives for mixing and painting; no plastic
- Natural bristle, synthetic or sable brushes in range of sizes including flat, bright, filbert, round
- **ONLY** Odorless Mineral Spirits allowed – Turpenoid, Gamsol
- Linseed oil; other mediums discussed including Allback Purified Boiled linseed oil
- Palette cups or small jars for oil & turpentine
- Cotton fabric or Scott Shop Towels – cut into quarters

NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, **Beginner-level classes**. These classes will be noted in the class description with “Some supplies included.” Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in **Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes**, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require **unconventional materials** (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
