WHAT TO EXPECT

If you have never taken a figure drawing class with live models before, here are some things you can expect:

- Models come in every shape, size and gender. Life drawing classes require you to spend 3 hours looking closely at the models, both with and without clothes. These models are professionals and are there to help you learn so you don't need to feel uncomfortable.
- Life drawing classes are meant to be quiet and discreet so plan not to go in or out of the studio unless absolutely necessary.
- Bring plenty of paper and drawing supplies with you.
- Please arrive early to prepare your station. Our models will start their poses on time.
- You will have short breaks during the class so the models can rest.
- Depending on how many students are in the studio, you may be able to move around to get a different view of the model.

A NOTE RE: TEEN CLASSES

Although no classes exclusively for teens are offered this season, motivated and responsible teens in grades 9-12 are invited to register for adult classes or workshops. All students under age 18 must have provide the School Office with written permission from a parent or guardian to register for Life Drawing Open Studios with nude models.
