



## Fall 2017 Class Supply List: Still Life Collage Workshop/ 7FAW61SD (Please see new policy re: class supplies below this list.)

- Light-weight or medium-weight drawing paper, 9 x 12 (any size will work) to make swatches
- Collage board—or any sturdy cardboard (about 9 x 12). Crescent Collage Board is acid-free.
- Acrylic paint—white plus primary and secondary colors
- 2 or 3 flat inexpensive brushes (utility or craft brushes are fine), about ½” wide
- Pencil
- Scissors—sharp
- X-acto knife with # 11 blades
- Tracing paper
- Nori, Mod Podge, or Yes paste
- 12” ruler
- Cutting mat (or piece of cardboard will work)

### NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, **Beginner-level classes**. These classes will be noted in the class description with “Some supplies included.” Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in **Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes**, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require **unconventional materials** (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
